



## SECAUCUS RECREATION CENTER

Secaucus, New Jersey



This project was the redevelopment of the existing Town of Secaucus skate park. The site is located on Koelle Boulevard and is bounded by the Mill Creek and Secaucus Wastewater Treatment Plant. The proposed development included a two-story recreational facility with a 25,000 SF footprint.

Neglia's responsibilities included regulatory coordination and design, for all site utilities, infrastructure, and site development. Site development activities included parking lot, site access, stormwater management and conveyances, and landscaping design.

Due to the development size and its close proximity to the Mill Creek, an NJDEP Stream Encroachment Permit, NJDEP Treatment Works Approval, and NJDEP Water Main Extension Permit. In addition, the project required an Army Corps of Engineers No Jurisdiction Determination.
